BIN No. 175ML 250ML BOTTLE

1. N.V. ZINGARO BIANCO VINO DI TAVOLO, ITALY – 1
£2.65 £3.45 £ 10.05

A well balanced, dry and fresh wine with crisp lemony fruit.

2. 2006 KLIPPENKOP CHENIN BLANC, S. AFRICA – 2
£2.85 £3.65 £ 11.10

This wine has a strong floral bouquet, pleasing crisp acidity and a long fresh flavour.

3. 2006 LAS CONDES SAUVIGNON BLANC, CHILE – 1
£2.95 £3.75 £ 11.40

Rich herbaceous aromas and flavours showing hints of gooseberry and lime acidity that follow through onto the palate.

**4. 2005 RUDESHEIMER ROSENGARTEN QBA – 4
NANGARTEN, GERMANY**
£2.95 £3.75 £ 11.40

A blended white wine with prominent Riesling presence and flowery bouquet with full rich flavours

5. 2005 GRANT BURGE BENCHMARK CHARDONNAY – 2
£3.60 £4.30 £ 14.25

Bright lemon in colour, with fresh, tropical peach and melon aromas and a creamy texture and mouthfeel. It is fresh, crisp and medium-bodied.

6. 2005 PETIT CHABLIS DOMAINE BOUCHARD, FRANCE – 1
£3.95 £4.70 £ 15.95

A wine expressing its youthful charms. A generous bouquet of fruit dominated by the bottle age. Typical mineral character with rich honey overtones.

7. PINOT GRIGIO VALLADE, DELLE VENEGIE, ITALY – 1
£3.40 £4.10 £ 13.10

Pale straw in colour, this wine is fresh, dry, fruity and full flavoured with a soft, gentle apple character.

ROSÉ

**8. 2006 PUCELA TEMPRANILLO ROSADO – 3
CASTILLA Y LEON, SPAIN**
£2.65 £3.45 £ 10.05

This Rosé wine is salmon pink in colour, aromas of fresh summer fruits dominated with a touch of strawberry on the palate.

RED

9. N.V. ZINGARO ROSSO VINO DI TAVOLO, ITALY – 1
£2.65 £3.45 £ 10.05

Ruby in colour with aromas of cherries and herbs carry through to the palate where they are balanced by an underlying firmness of tone

10. LAS CONDES MERLOT, CHILE – 2
£2.95 £3.75 £ 11.40

Raspberry red in colour with fruity aromas and delicate herbal hints. This medium bodied wine offers plum and prune flavours, it is soft and supple with a clean and fruity finish.

11. 2005 KLIPPENKOP CINSAUT/SHIRAZ, S. AFRICA – 3
£3.40 £4.10 £ 13.25

The Cinsaut grape lends a softness to the fuller, richer Shiraz grape producing an interesting, fruity wine with a hint of spice.

**12. PUCELA TEMPRANILLO/CABERNET – 2
CASTILLA Y LEON, SPAIN**
£3.30 £4.00 £ 12.90

Rich black cherry colour with good intense aromas with a touch of oak. The palate is well balanced with red fruit flavours and a hint of spice.

13. 2005 GRANT BURGE BENCHMARK SHIRAZ, AUSTRALIA – 4
£3.60 £4.30 £ 14.25

Enticing aromas of black pepper and spice are balanced with hints of raspberry and black cherry, and the palate is soft and generous with flavours of red berries and cherries.

14. 2004 RIVALLANA CRIANZA, SPAIN – 4
£4.00 £4.70 £ 15.95

A fine example of Rioja, beautifully aged in oak, smooth and subtle with the added complexity of vanilla. Rich and rounded on the palate with a lingering finish.
